## Hard Refuse Collection Policy and Guidelines

---

### **2017 Collection Dates**

Preston Beach/ Lake Clifton Town sites

Commencing Monday 14th August

Waroona/ Hamel Town sites

Commencing Tuesday 22nd August

Please note:

Collection material may be placed up to seven (7) days prior to the scheduled start date for your specific area. Material presented prior to seven (7) days or not collected due to non-compliance with collection conditions, will be monitored and may result in an infringement notice being issued in accordance with the Litter Act 1979.

Maximum penalty for an individual: \$5000

## Guidelines

Hard refuse should be placed neatly on the verge as close as possible to the kerb and your driveway.

The following items will be collected from your verge:

- ✓ **WHITE GOODS**  
(Fridges stoves, microwaves etc)  
Doors must be removed from fridges and freezers. Fridges and Freezers should also be de-gassed. Non de-gassed fridges and freezers will not be collected.
- ✓ **TELEVISIONS**
- ✓ **SCRAP METAL**
- ✓ **GENERAL JUNK** (furniture and general house hold items)

The white goods and scrap metal should be placed on the verge in a pile separate to the other hard refuse as this will be collected separately and recycled.

Please note that all items of hard refuse will be collected by hand. A maximum weight will apply, and as a general rule two (2) people should be able to lift the item easily to shoulder height.

Maximum volume of hard refuse to be collected from each resident is two (2) cubic metres.

## What Won't Be Collected

The following items will not be collected:

- ✗ **Sand**
- ✗ **Bricks, Concrete or Building Rubble**
- ✗ **Tyres, Car Bodies and Vehicle Parts**
- ✗ **Batteries**
- ✗ **Food Products**
- ✗ **Hazardous Waste** ( paints, chemicals, oil or gas cylinders)
- ✗ **Asbestos Products**
- ✗ **Glass or Mirrors**
- ✗ **Green Waste** (grass clippings, tree pruning's, weeds ect)
- ✗ **Fridges & Freezers** presented with out degassing

All the above material can either be taken to the Shire's Refuse Disposal Site or removed by contacting a local rubbish bin operator.

## General Conditions

Please note this service is available in town sites only—please refer to the maps located at the Shire Admin Office, Preston Beach General Store, Preston Beach Community Centre and the Lake Clifton Community Centre.

It is important that residents pay close attention to the requirements of the verge collections. Non compliance with these requirements may result in some of the waste remaining on the verge and or a possible infringement notice being issued in accordance with the Litter Act 1979.

- ✓ All waste is to be placed in a pile neatly on the verge no earlier than seven (7) days prior to the advertised collection week and no later than 6:00am on the scheduled start date for your area—roads will only be checked once.
- ✓ Allow 5-7 working days for your collection.
- ✓ Place all waste on the verge without obstructing footpaths, your normal bin service or the line of sight of pedestrians, cyclist and cars.
- ✗ Do not place waste inside your property boundary.
- ✗ Waste will not be collected from Vacant Properties, Public Land or outside the specified Town Sites.
